

To have a good understanding of *Fundamental of Communication*, it requires *Understanding the Principle of Communication* plus the prerequisite exercise for *Fundamental of Communication*.

In addition to that, to help us with the understanding of *Fundamental of Communication* from *Understanding the Principle of Communication*, it makes sense for us to view things in the following forms:

For instance, from *Understanding the Principle of Communication* we view something like this.

Communication enables us to do things. We communicate to do what we do.

In Fundamental of Communication we view the same thing like this

We do things according to what we think. We depend on what we think to do what we do.
